

Campground Rules:

- * NO DOGS ALLOWED on any part of the fair grounds including campgrounds during the fair.
- *ABOVE GROUND fire pits ONLY with adult supervision. DO NOT dump cold ashes on the ground.
- *An adult, 21 years old or older must stay with any minor staying overnight at the fair.
- *Any use of alcohol by minors or illegal drug use by any individual will not be tolerated and should be immediately reported to security at 773-1000 or dial 911. (Security is on the grounds)
- *No gray water or sewage on the ground. Dump station available by south bathrooms for Fair Grounds Campers only. On site tank cleaning available by Guiett Portables, check at Fair Office.
- *Your camping space is halfway between the electric poles. Your awning and slide outs must stay within this space. Be sure to measure, we would hate to make you move after you are setup.
- *Put all garbage in dumpsters provided.
- *Campers may be brought in on **Friday, July 31st after 1:00 pm** and must leave by **Sunday, August 8th 1:00 pm**. A \$40 fee per day will be charged to early campers and/or any camper left after 1:00 pm on July 27th. If this payment is not made to the fair office you may lose your camping space for the 2027 fair.

GOLF CART/VEHICLES POLICY

Revised 2026

For the safety of all fairgoers the following rules are in effect when the vehicle is unloaded at the fairgrounds. With everyone's cooperation we can continue the convenience of using off road vehicles during fair week. Operators must have a valid driver's license. Golf cart/vehicles must always be operated in a safe and orderly manner.

1. Golf cart/vehicle must have a permit at a cost of \$50.00 purchased at the Fair Office. The permit must be displayed on the golf cart/vehicle and be visible. **All golf carts/vehicles must possess an insurance policy that provides a minimum \$300,000 liability insurance coverage for operation of the vehicle on the fairgrounds.** The written document of this coverage must be submitted when the vehicle is registered.
2. The operator may not transport more individuals than the vehicle has manufactured seats for.
3. Vehicles must park in the designated area provided.
4. Vehicles may not be driven in restricted areas such as: Midway, any paved areas or around buildings.
5. Speed limit of **10 mph** must be followed. Golf carts/vehicles violating the speed limit will be asked to leave the grounds immediately.
6. The intent of golf cart/vehicles on the fairgrounds is to assist with animal chores, transportation of guests with limited mobility and official fair activities.
7. No recreational or sightseeing usage allowed at any time.
8. **NO WARNINGS WILL BE GIVEN.** If any of these rules are broken the vehicle must be removed from the grounds or immobilized. Failure to do so may result in possible expulsion from the grounds and/or loss of camp site.
9. **Board Members, Superintendents and Security Patrol will be monitoring these rules.**
